On the previous homepage, information and resources were organized under three headers:


- 1. Get to Know the Standards

This updated section of the website enables users to:


Search for and/or read the student performance expectations (the standards).

Understand how and why the standards are arranged and organized to advance science education in the classroom, and why science standards needed an update.


Understand how the standards were developed and who was involved during development.

Discover tools and resources that help unpack the standards and what they mean for instruction and assessment.


Understand what the standards and three-dimensional learning should look like in classrooms.
